ABOUT EUROPEAN DIPLOMACY WORKSHOP



The **European Diplomacy Workshop (EDW)** is a flagship week-long course devoted to the evolving Foreign Policy of the European Union. Addressed to professionals from all walks of life, the workshop creates a forum for discussion about the nature of EU foreign policy and the challenges it encounters. The program is also an opportunity to broaden knowledge on the different regional and thematic aspects of EU external relations and European diplomacy, as well as acquire and practice essential skills necessary for shaping the modern world.

Organized since 2010 by the European Academy of Diplomacy with cooperation with Konrad Adenauer Stiftung Foundation, the EDW takes place twice a year – in the Spring and Autumn, **each time bringing to Warsaw around 20 professionals representing 10-15 from around the globe.**

The program establishes a network of emerging political and social leaders, public servants and non-governmental representatives, interested in enhancing their understanding of the European Union and its role in the world. Since 2010, in the framework of 18 EDW editions, over 400 participants from 60 countries have graduated from the program.

The program covers topics such as: Introduction to Foreign Policy, Global Governance, EU Decision Making, EU – China Relations, EU – Russia relations, EU – Eastern Partnership, EU and international conflicts, enriched by different study visits.
